

ATHLETE MEDIA REQUIREMENTS

2018 YOUTH SAILING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Athlete Medal Race Media Requirements (AMR) outlines the media environment that will be in operation during the Youth Sailing World Championships (Youth Worlds) in Corpus Christi, Texas, USA and sets out how athletes will engage with media and associated obligations from 14-21 July 2018.
- 1.2 The Youth Worlds Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions (NoR/SI), Corpus Christi Sailing Instructions (CCSI) and supporting documents on penalties clarify media rights and obligations.

2. Media Representation

- 2.1 Chris Love Productions have been appointed as the Host Broadcaster for the Youth Worlds, providing daily video news releases, highlights programming, news interviews and social media coverage. This production will be unbiased international coverage. Chris Love Productions has priority media access to the venue and the competition areas, including the boat park and launching ramp.
- 2.2 Jen Edney and James Tomlinson have been appointed as the official photographers for the Youth Worlds and will provide daily unbiased international coverage.
- 2.3 Other broadcasters will be present, together with photographic and written media journalists. They will have access to on-water controlled areas and regatta venue.
- 2.4 Accredited media boats will be clearly identified on the water. The movement of media boats will be controlled to ensure minimal disturbance to racing.

3. Media Requirements

- 3.1 Before Racing
 - a) Media representatives will be present in the boat park and beach
 - b) Athletes will be required for pre-race interviews if requested
- 3.2 After racing
 - a) All sailors shall return to the ramp immediately
 - b) Athletes will be required for post-race interviews if requested
