AMENDMENT TO THE NoR/SI #3

1. Add a new NoR/SI 1.13:
In RRS 30.4 and RRS P1 change 'sail number' to 'national letters'.
2. Add a new NoR/SI 15.7:
[DP] A buoy may be attached to the stern of the race committee starting boat. Boats shall not pass between this buoy and the race committee starting boat at any time.
This buoy is part of the race committee starting boat.
3. Add a new CCSI 14.6:
Off set mark (1A), when used, will be orange spheres.
4. Add a new CCSI 13.3:
The First meeting with Competitors on Sunday 15 will be at 09.30 in the boat park (this changes NoR/SI 13.1).
There will be a morning Team Leader meeting starting on 16 July at 0900 in the Ball Room at the Hotel,
